STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

- 1. Andrew H. Gorski, R.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(2) and (5) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(a) and (c) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing in that in or about December 2014, during the course of his employment with the Virginia School for Nurse Aides, Richmond, Virginia, where he worked as an instructor, he administered influenza vaccine belonging to another employer, Health Solutions, to multiple students without authorization.
- 2. Mr. Gorski may be in violation of § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code in that he may be unable to safely practice nursing due to substance abuse, as evidenced by his consumption of alcohol while on duty with the Virginia School for Nurse Aides.
