CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Kasey Smith, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Smith's application for certification to practice as a certified nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Kasey Smith submitted an application for certification by examination to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia which was received by the Board on February 23, 2015.
- 2. On January 6, 2011, Ms. Smith was convicted of one count of misdemeanor shoplifting in the Stafford County, Virginia, General District Court. Ms. Smith was sentenced to 60 days in jail with 60 days suspended, contingent upon good behavior for a period of 3 years. Ms. Smith was also ordered to pay a \$150.00 fine and was barred from all Walmart properties in Stafford County, Virginia.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of §54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
- 2. The Board concludes that Ms. Smith otherwise meets the requirements of §54.1-3023 of the Code.

CONSENT

Kasey Smith, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her application except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her:
 - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for certification to practice as a certified nurse aide in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of Kasey Smith for certification to practice as a certified nurse aide in Virginia is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NNAAP Examination, Ms. Smith shall be issued an unrestricted certificate to practice as a certified nurse aide.
 - Ms. Smith is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Ms. Smith shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a certified nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.
