**CONSENT ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and George Kendall Hazer, as evidenced by his signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. Hazer's application for reinstatement of his certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. George Kendall Hazer was issued Certificate No. 1401-121278 to practice as a nurse aide by the Virginia Board of Nursing on October 18, 2007. Said certificate expired on November 9, 2012.
2. Mr. Hazer submitted an application for reinstatement of his certificate which was received by the Board on March 2, 2015.
3. On June 19, 2012, Mr. Hazer was convicted in the General District Court of Lynchburg, Virginia, of one count of petit larceny, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. He was sentenced to six months incarceration with five months suspended and was ordered to pay court costs and restitution.
4. Mr. Hazer paid all costs and restitution by April 15, 2014.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. Finding of Fact No. 3 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
2. Mr. Hazer otherwise meets the requirements for reinstatement of his nurse aide certificate.

**CONSENT**

George Kendall Hazer, by affixing his signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. He has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. He acknowledges that without his consent, no legal action can be taken against him except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. He acknowledges that he has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against him;
4. He waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. He admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives his right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. He consents to the entry of the following Order affecting his application for reinstatement of his certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

**ORDER**

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of George Kendall Hazer for reinstatement of his certification to practice as a nurse aide is APPROVED. Mr. Hazer shall be issued an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.
2. Mr. Hazer is hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Mr. Hazer shall maintain a course of conduct in his capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.

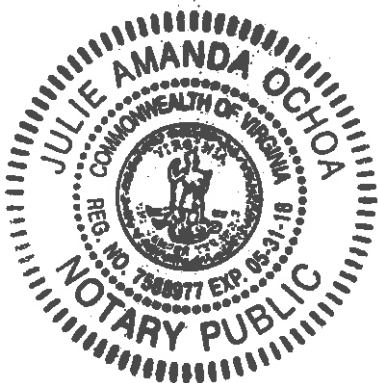
