CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Stacey J. Barbour, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Barbour's application for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Stacey J. Barbour was issued Certificate No. 1401-155187 to practice as a nurse aide by the Virginia Board of Nursing on August 22, 2012. Said certificate expired on August 31, 2014.
- 2. Ms. Barbour submitted an application for reinstatement of her certificate which was received by the Board on February 2, 2015.
- 3. On May 2, 2014, Ms. Barbour was convicted in the General District Court of the City of Roanoke, Virginia, of one count of shoplifting, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. She was sentenced to 30 days incarceration with 26 days suspended for a period of 12 months on the condition that she remain of good behavior. She was also ordered to pay fines and restitution.
 - Ms. Barbour paid all fines and restitution on August 7, 2014.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that:

1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").

2. Ms. Barbour otherwise meets the requirements for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide.

CONSENT

Stacey J. Barbour, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Consent Order affecting her application for the reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

<u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Consent Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of Stacey J. Barbour for reinstatement of her certification to practice as a nurse aide is hereby APPROVED. The Board shall issue Ms. Barbour an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
 - 2. Ms. Barbour is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Ms. Barbour shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
