**ORDER** 

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 54.1-110 and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), a formal administrative hearing was held before a panel of the Board of Nursing ("Board") on March 26, 2015, in Henrico County, Virginia, to inquire into evidence that Chicqueta A. Elliott, L.P.N., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing practical nursing practice in Virginia. The case was presented by Tammie D. Jones, Adjudication Specialist, Administrative Proceedings Division. Charis A. Mitchell, Assistant Attorney General, was present as legal counsel for the Board. Ms. Elliott was present and was not represented by legal counsel. The proceedings were recorded by a certified court reporter.

Upon consideration of the evidence presented, the Board adopted the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Chicqueta A. Elliott, L.P.N., was issued License No. 0002-066558 to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia on July 7, 2003. Said license expires on August 31, 2016. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
- 2. During the course of her employment with LifeStyle Lift, Virginia Beach, Virginia, Ms. Elliott falsified patient records by failing to document the administration of hydrocodone to Patients A, B, C and D, despite her documentation on the Daily Medication Administration log.
- 3. Ms. Elliott testified that the patients' physician verbally ordered these medications be administered as needed when the patient was uncomfortable.

4. At the hearing, Ms. Elliott admitted that she failed to properly document on the days in question.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(2) and (5) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(e) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.

## **ORDER**

WHEREFORE, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Chicqueta A. Elliott, L.P.N., is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 2. Ms. Elliott shall provide the Board with verification that she has completed the following NCSBN online courses within 90 days of the entry of this Order: Medication Errors: Detection and Prevention; and Professional Accountability and Legal Liability for Nurses.
- 3. Ms. Elliott shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.
- 4. Any violation of the terms and conditions of this Order or of any law or regulation affecting the practice of nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia shall constitute grounds for the suspension or revocation of the license of Chicqueta A. Elliott, L.P.N., and an administrative proceeding shall be convened to determine whether such license shall be suspended or revoked.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.
