**NOTICE OF HEARING**

At the hearing, Ms. Brown has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Brown desires any

witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Brown may have violated certain laws

governing nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

## STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Jennifer Brown, L.P.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code in that she may be unsafe to practice practical nursing due to mental illness. Specifically, between on or about May 13, 2013, and January 25, 2014, Ms. Brown was hospitalized three times under an emergency custody order or a temporary detention order, and diagnosed with a psychotic disorder, anxiety, and schizoaffective disorder, bipolar type.
