ORDER

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4019, 2.2-4021, and 54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), a Special Conference Committee (“Committee”) of the Virginia Board of Nursing (“Board”) met on April 5, 2016, in Henrico County, Virginia, to receive and act upon the application of Yvonne R. Beasley for reinstatement of her license to practice practical nursing in Virginia and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Beasley may have violated certain laws and regulations governing practical nursing practice. Ms. Beasley was present and was not represented by legal counsel.

Upon consideration of the evidence, the Committee adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Yvonne R. Beasley was issued License No. 0002-070529 to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia on January 4, 2005. Said license was suspended by Order of the Board entered on April 7, 2015. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. By letter dated February 29, 2016, the Board of Nursing sent a Notice of Informal Conference (“Notice”) to Ms. Beasley notifying her that an informal conference would be held on April 5, 2016. The Notice was sent by certified and first class mail to 301 Plazaview Road, Room 1, Richmond, Virginia 23224, the address of record on file with the Board of Nursing. The Notice was also sent to 3937 Merry Oaks Avenue, Richmond, Virginia 23224, a secondary address.
3. Ms. Beasley submitted an application for reinstatement of her license to practice practical nursing which was received by the Board on September 15, 2015.

4. By Order of the Board entered on April 7, 2015, Ms. Beasley's license was suspended due to findings that she failed to provide in-home care to a patient ordered to receive insulin.

5. On the application for employment with Maxim Healthcare, Richmond, Virginia, dated December 6, 2013:

a. Ms. Beasley falsely indicated her reason for leaving Envoy of Westover Hills, Richmond, Virginia, as change in management, when, in fact, her employment was terminated.

b. Ms. Beasley falsely indicated her reason for leaving Care Advantage, Richmond, Virginia, as not enough work, when, in fact, her employment was terminated.

6. Ms. Beasley reported that she was never notified of her termination from Care Advantage.

7. Ms. Beasley stated that she was previously enrolled in an online nursing program at the University of Indiana and that she withdrew from the program after her license was suspended. Ms. Beasley provided documentation of completion of the required continuing education hours. Ms. Beasley has been employed at the Amazon Fulfillment Center since October 2015. A friend accompanied Ms. Beasley to the informal conference and spoke on her behalf.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Finding of Fact No. 5 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(2) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(e) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.

2. The Committee concludes that Yvonne R. Beasley has demonstrated satisfactory evidence that she is prepared to resume practice in a safe and competent manner.

ORDER

On the basis of the foregoing, the Committee hereby ORDERS as follows:


1. The license of Yvonne R. Beasley to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby REINSTATED. Ms. Beasley shall be issued an unrestricted license.

2. Ms. Beasley shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.



Douglas, M.S.M., R.N., C.S.A.C., F.R.E., Executive Director, Board of Nursing, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in writing that she desires a formal administrative hearing before the Board. Upon the filing with the Executive Director of a request for the hearing, this Order shall be vacated.
