## **CONSENT ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Lasasha L. Lane, L.P.N., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Lane's license to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Lasasha L. Lane, L.P.N., was issued License No. 0002-088406 to practice practical nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on January 8, 2013. Said license is set to expire on September 30, 2016. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
- 2. During the course of her employment with Health Partners Home Care, Hampton, Virginia, on June 15, 2014, Ms. Lane submitted skilled nursing notes that falsely indicated she visited a patient on June 13, 14 and 15, 2014, and in which she forged the client's signature.
  - Ms. Lane's employment was terminated on June 16, 2014.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(2) and (5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(e) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.

- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et sea. of the Code:
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
  - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her right to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

#### <u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Lasasha L. Lane, L.P.N., is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 2. Ms. Lane shall pay a MONETARY PENALTY of \$250.00 to the Board within 90 days of the entry of this Order.
- 3. Ms. Lane shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.
- 4. Any violation of the terms and conditions of this Order or of any law or regulation affecting the practice of nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia shall constitute grounds for the suspension or revocation

of the license of Lasasha L. Lane, L.P.N., and an administrative proceeding shall be convened to determine whether such license shall be suspended or revoked.
