**ORDER** 

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of

FINDINGS OF FACT

By Order of the Board entered on August 11, 2011, Ms. Blandford was placed on indefinite 2.

probation for three years of active employment as a professional nurse, with terms and conditions. Said

action was due to findings of fact that Ms. Blandford was convicted of driving while under the influence in

the Superior Court of Sacramento County, California. Subsequently, the California Board of Registered

Nursing revoked her license with the revocation stayed and Ms. Blandford was placed on probation for three

years, with terms and conditions.

Ms. Blandford submitted a petition for release from probation on August 27, 2014. 3.

Ms. Blandford has complied with all terms and conditions of probation. 4.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

## **ORDER**

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petition of Katrina R. Blandford, R.N., for release from probation is hereby GRANTED and Ms. Blandford shall be issued a license to practice as a professional nurse, that is valid in Virginia only.

Ms. Blandford shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
