Dear Ms. Holzman:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered March 27, 2015. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

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

ORDER OF SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF NURSING, PURSUANT TO SECTION 12-38-116.5(8)(a), C.R.S.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LICENSE TO PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL NURSING IN THE STATE OF COLORADO OF DIANE HOPE HOLZMAN, RN LICENSE NUMBER 61890,

Respondent.

TO: Diane Hope Holzman, RN ("Respondent")

The State Board of Nursing, ("Board"), has reasonable cause to believe and finds that Respondent failed to comply with a valid Board Order issued pursuant to section 12-38-116.5(8)(a), C.R.S. Pursuant to section 12-38-116.5(8)(a), C.R.S., after careful review and consideration, the Board finds and orders that Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Colorado is hereby suspended by the Board effective March 2, 2015, based on the following:

- Respondent was licensed to practice as a professional nurse in the State of Colorado on September 1, 1978, and was issued license number 61890. Respondent's professional nurse license expired on September 30, 2014.
- 2. On or about October 29, 2014, the Board reviewed all matters set forth in Board Case Number 2014-3200. Specifically, the Board reviewed information involving the Respondent's mental condition. Based on this information and the totality of the circumstances, the Board had reasonable cause to believe that Respondent is unable to practice nursing with reasonable skill and safety to patients because of a condition listed in section(s) 12-38-117(i), C.R.S. Thus, the Board ordered Respondent to submit to a mental examination pursuant to section 12-38-116.5(8)(a), C.R.S.
- 3. On or about November 12, 2014, the Board issued and mailed an Order ("Order") to Respondent to attend an appointment for a mental examination at Peer Assistance Services ("PAS"), 2170 South Parker Road, Suite 229, Denver, CO 80231. The appointment was scheduled for December, 2, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. Respondent was ordered to schedule additional timely appointments as necessary, to appear for all appointments with PAS, to provide any information requested by PAS, and to otherwise cooperate fully with PAS. Respondent was further ordered to continue thereafter to fully cooperate with PAS in a timely manner and to comply with any and all requests PAS deemed appropriate to facilitate any and all examinations
- 4. On or about November 18, 2014, Peer Assistance Services (PAS) informed the Board that the Respondent contacted PAS and the Board to say that she is living in another State and would not comply with the Board's Order to complete and examination at Peer Assistance Services.



- 5. According to section 12-38-116.5(8)(a), C.R.S., Respondent's failure to comply with the requirements of the Board's Order is a violation of that Order and is grounds for
- 6. Pursuant to section 12-38-116.5(8)(a), C.R.S., the Board is authorized to suspend Respondent's license to practice professional nursing in the State of Colorado until Respondent fully complies with the Board's Order.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, in accordance with section 12-38-116(8)(a), C.R.S., that the license to practice professional nursing of Diane Hope Holzman is suspended, effective 5:00 P.M., on March 2, 2015. Any such suspension shall remain in effect until lifted by the Board and Respondent has received written notice from the Board that the suspension has been vacated. The Board shall lift the suspension upon review of evidence establishing that the Respondent has resumed compliance with the Board's November 12, 2014 Order.

COMMENCING AT 5:00 P.M. ON MARCH 2, 2015, RESPONDENT SHALL NOT ENGAGE IN OR PERFORM ANY ACT REQUIRING A COLORADO LICENSE TO PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL NURSING.
