Dear Ms. Perkins:

This is official notification that an informal Conference will be held, pursuant to \$ 54.1-100 and \$ 54.1-3010 of the Code of Virginia (1980), as amended, on June 4, 1901, at 10:00 a.m. at the Department of Health Professions, Conference Room 2, 1801 Rolling Hills Drive, Richmond, Virginia.

The Special Conference Committee, which is comprised of three members of the Virginia Board of Nursing, will inquire into allegations that you may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of mursing in Virginia.

Specifically, you may have violated \$ 54.1-3007 (2) and (5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, and \$ 4.1B(5) of the Board of Muruing Regulations in that:

- 1. Between on or about December 16, 1988 and December 19, 1988, during the course of your employment at Home Care Resources, Inc., Virginia Beach, Virginia, you documented and billed for four (4) home health care visits to Patient A, when, in fact, you had made only two (2) home health care visits during this period.
- 2. On or about February 7, 1800, during the course of your employment at Home Care Resources, Inc., Virginia Beach, Virginia, you documented and billed for two (2) home health care visits to Patient B which you had not, in fact, performed. On May 1, 1990, you were terminated from employment due to these incidents.

You may be represented by an attorney at the Informal Conference. After reviewing the alleged violations with you, the Special Conference Committee will make a recommendation of appropriate action. If the Conference Committee is of the opinion that the charges are without foundation, you will be notified that you record has been cleared of any charge which might affect your right to practice nursing in the Commenwealth of Virginia. If the Conference Committee is of the opinion that disminsal of

the charges is not appropriate, the Committee shall either: (i) with you consent, present the Committee's findings and conclusions in writing to the full Board with the recommendation for disciplinary sunction, or (ii) refer the case for a formal hearing in accordance with § \$4.1-110 and § \$-6.14:12 of the Code of Virginia.

Should you full to appear at the informal Conference, the Beard may proceed to a formal administrative hearing in order to impose sanctions. Please inform this office of you intention to appear at the hearing at least ten (10) days prior to the scheduled date specified above. Also, please inform the Board office of a telephone number where you may be reached.

Enclosed you will find copies of the relevant sections of the Administrative Process Act, which governs proceedings of this nature, as well as the laws and regulations relating to the practice of narraing in Virginia.
