NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Michelle Mullins, C.N.A., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on October 10, 2014, held Certificate No. 1401-060048 to practice as a nurse aide, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on January 28, 2015, at 2:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Mullins will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Mullins has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Mullins desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Mullins may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on November 14, 2012, and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Mullins may have violated certain laws governing nurse aide practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Michelle Mullins C.N.A., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term 4(a) of the Board's Order entered November 14, 2014, which required her to comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), in that on or about September 19, 2014, Ms. Mullins was dismissed from the HPMP for noncompliance with her program contract. Specifically, Ms. Mullins missed reporting for drug screens on August 13, 2014, and August 15, 2014. Ms. Mullins has not called the testing line since August 18, 2014, and had failed to contact her HPMP case manager.
