Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered March 4, 2015. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

This case came before the Court for trial of the defendant, who appeared in person with her attorney, George Neskis. Commonwealth was represented by Megan M. Blancho.

Whereupon the defendant waived arraignment and the Court having been advised by the defendant, her counsel and the attorney for the Commonwealth that there has been a PLEA AGREEMENT in this case, and such agreement in writing having been presented to the Court, and now filed herein, and having heard the evidence and argument of counsel, the Court accepts said agreement and the plea of guilty to Obtain Drug by Fraud, that the defendant tendered in person and finds the defendant guilty of same.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court SENTENCES the defendant to:

Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: 3 years and a \$150.00 fine for Obtain Drug by Fraud. total sentence imposed is 3 years and a \$150.00 fine.

This sentence shall run consecutively with all other sentences.

The Court SUSPENDS 3 years of the Obtain Drug by Fraud sentence, for a period of 3 years, for a total suspension of 3 years, upon the following condition(s):

Unsupervised probation. The defendant shall be of uniform good behavior while in custody and for 3 years after release from all confinement.

Supervised probation. The defendant is placed on probation to commence on his release from incarceration, under the supervision of a Probation Officer for an indeterminate period, until released by the Court or the Probation Officer. The defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer. The defendant will be in violation of is probation should he maintain, frequent, reside in or be at a house or place where illegal drugs, narcotics, or marijuana are manufactured, distributed, possessed with intent to distribute, or used, either by himself or other persons.

The defendant shall undergo drug testing and treatment.

The defendant's driver's license shall be suspended for 6 months from the date of judgment and the defendant shall surrender his license to the Court.

Fines/Costs/Restitution. The following amounts are due and payable at the time of sentencing. If the total payment is not made on the date of sentencing, the defendant shall enter into an Installment Agreement Plan with the Circuit Court Clerk's Office and a judgment entered therein. All payments are to be made payable to the Clerk, Norfolk Circuit Court. Payments shall be made at the rate of \$50.00 per month commencing October 12, 2011.
