**CONSENT ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Hannah Irene Schelly, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Schelly's application for licensure by examination to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On November 30, 2014, Hannah Irene Schelly submitted an application for licensure by examination to practice practical nursing in Virginia.
2. On May 1, 2013, in the General District Court of the City of Colonial Heights, Virginia, Ms. Schelly was convicted of petit larceny. The court required that Ms. Schelly complete a shoplifter's prevention program, perform 40 hours of community service, and pay all court fines and costs totaling \$191.00. Ms. Schelly successfully completed all court imposed terms on or before July 23, 2013.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
2. Ms. Schelly otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3020 of the Code.

**CONSENT**

Hannah Irene Schelly, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;

3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;

4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;

5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;

6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for licensure by examination to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

### ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Hannah Irene Schelly for licensure by examination is hereby APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NCLEX-PN examination, Ms. Schelly shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice as a practical nurse in the Commonwealth.

2. Hannah Irene Schelly is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Hannah Irene Schelly shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a licensed practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public

inspection or copying upon request.
