Upon motion of Counsel for the defendant, the Court will remand the defendant to the Department of Corrections for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days for evaluation of participation in the Detention and Diversion Center Programs, and Secor, pursuant to §19.2-316.2, 19.2-316.3, 53.1-67.7 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended. Sentencing is deferred pending the return of the evaluation. Sentencing is set for August 18, 2016 at 1:30 PM.

The defendant appeared this day for sentencing as directed. The Court, having previously found the defendant guilty of violating the terms and conditions of her probation, was advised the defendant was acceptable to the Detention and Diversion Center Program.

Further, the defendant is to be held until picked up by the Detention staff.

DRUG SCREENING, ASSESSMENT AND TRAINING PROGRAM. The defendant shall complete any substance abuse screening, assessment, testing and treatment as directed by the Department of Corrections. The defendant is subject to payment of any fees associated with substance abuse treatment or intervention as required by the treatment of intervention program on an ability to pay basis.
