ORDER

In accordance with §§ 2.2-4019, 2.2-4021 and 54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), an informal conference was conducted on behalf of the Board of Nursing ("Board") on January 21, 2015, in Henrico County, Virginia. Daphne McKinney was present and was not represented by legal counsel. Jane Elliott, R.N., Ph.D., serving as Agency Subordinate for the Board, submitted a Recommended Decision for consideration.

Based upon its review of the Recommended Decision of the Agency Subordinate, the Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and issues the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Daphne McKinney was issued Certificate No. 1401-061611 to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia on October 15, 1996. The certificate expired on November 9, 2012.
2. Ms. McKinney submitted an application for registration by examination to practice as a medication aide which was received by the Board on January 24, 2014.
3. By letter dated December 22, 2014, the Board of Nursing sent a Notice of Informal Conference ("Notice") to Ms. McKinney notifying her that an informal conference would be held on January 21, 2015. The Notice was sent by certified and first class mail to 996 North Loudon Street, Winchester, Virginia 22601, the address of record on file with the Board of Nursing.
4. Ms. McKinney stated that she initially completed the medication administration course on January 15, 2014. She has taken the examination twice, without success. Ms. McKinney stated that she has taken the course again, and completed it on December 11, 2014, and plans to take the examination on

January 27, 2015.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Ms. McKinney meets the qualifications of § 54.1-3020 of the Code.


ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the application of Daphne McKinney for registration by examination to practice as a medication aide is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the Medication Aide examination, Ms. McKinney shall be issued an unrestricted registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.


Pursuant to Section 54.1-2400(10) of the Code, Ms. McKinney may, not later than 5:00 p.m., on **March 9, 2015**, notify Jay P. Douglas, M.S.M., R.N., C.S.A.C., F.R.E., Executive Director, Board of Nursing, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in writing that she desires a formal administrative hearing before the Board. Upon the filing with the Executive Director of a request for the hearing, this Order shall be vacated.
