ORDER

Upon petition of Diana Palmer for termination of her probation, a Special Conference was held on March 4, 1993, in Henrico County, Virginia, pursuant to § 54.1-110 and § 54.1-3010 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("the Code"). Ms. Palmer was not present.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. A Consent Order was entered by the Virginia Board of Nursing in the matter of Diana Palmer, R.N., on January 30, 1991, placing Ms. Palmer's license to practice professional nursing on probation with terms and conditions.
- 2. Ms. Palmer has complied with the terms and conditions of her probation.
- 3. Ms. Palmer is able to engage in the unrestricted practice of professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the Findings of Fact, the Board conclude that Diana Palmer, R.N., has met the requirements of § 54.1-3009.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby Ordered that the petition of Diana Palmer, R.N, for termination of probation be granted and that she be issued an unrestricted license to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to § 9-6.14:14 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the signed original of the Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.
