CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Sherronda S. Bassett, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Bassett's application for registration by examination to practice as a medication aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Sherronda S. Bassett submitted an application for registration by examination as a medication aide, which was received by the Board on April 18, 2014.
- 2. On April 15, 2011, Ms. Bassett was convicted of petit larceny, a misdemeanor, in the Williamsburg/James City County General District Court. She was sentenced to nine days incarceration, with nine days suspended. She was also placed on supervised probation and ordered to pay fines and court costs, which have been paid in full.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Findings of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
 - 2. Ms. Bassett otherwise meets the qualifications of § 54.1-3042 of the Code.

CONSENT

Sherronda S. Bassett, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for registration by examination to practice as a medication aide in Virginia.

<u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of Sherronda S. Bassett for registration by examination as a medication aide is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the Medication Aide examination, Ms. Bassett shall be issued a registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth.
 - 2. Ms. Bassett is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. Ms. Bassett shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a medication aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Regulations Governing the Registration of Medication Aides.
