CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Paul M. Colton, R.N., as evidenced by their

signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to a formal administrative proceeding, enter into the following

Consent Order affecting Mr. Colton's license to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of

Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Paul M. Colton, R.N., was issued License Number 0001-233424 to practice professional

nursing on August 31, 2011, which is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2019. Mr. Colton was also issued

License Number 0024-170972 to practice as a nurse practitioner in the area of psychiatry and mental

health on July 2, 2013, which is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2019. Mr. Colton was also issued

Authorization to Prescribe Number 0017-141152 on March 20, 2014, which is scheduled to expire on

June 30, 2019. His primary state of residence is Virginia.

2. By Consent Order of the Board entered January 13, 2015, the Board reprimanded Mr.

Colton based on findings that he had prescribed medications without holding an authorization to

prescribe in Virginia.

3. On March 13, 2017, the New York Board of Regents accepted Mr. Colton's application

to surrender his license to practice as a registered professional nurse in the State of New York in lieu of

disciplinary action. At the time, the New York State Education Department, Office of Professional

Discipline, State Board for Nursing, had brought disciplinary action against Mr. Colton based on the

Virginia Board of Nursing's Consent Order. On July 18, 2017, the Virginia Department of Health Professions suspended Mr. Colton's license to practice professional nursing in Virginia pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, based on the action of the New York Board of Regents.

4. The matter of the reinstatement of Mr. Colton's license to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is properly before the Board.

CONSENT

Paul M. Colton, R.N., by affixing his signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

- 1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my license except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 et seq.;
- 3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to a formal administrative hearing before the Board; the right to representation by counsel; and the right to cross-examine witnesses against me;
 - 4. I waive my right to a formal hearing;
- 5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
- 6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my licensure to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS that the license of Paul M. Colton, R.N., to practice professional nursing in Virginia is REINSTATED without restriction.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
