NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Rachel Y. Craddock, L.P.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on June 3, 2014, held License No. 0002-059799 to practice practical nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on September 17, 2014, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms.

At the hearing, Ms. Craddock has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Craddock desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Rachel Y. Craddock, L.P.N., may have violated certain laws governing practical nursing practice in Virginia and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Craddock may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on May 15, 2012, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

- 1. Rachel Y. Craddock, L.P.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term No. 5 of the Order entered May 15, 2012, which required her to comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), in that, on or about July 19, 2013, Ms. Craddock was dismissed from the HPMP due to noncompliance with the toxicology screening program. Specifically:
 - a. On or about June 13, 2012, Ms. Craddock tested positive for marijuana.
- b. On or about August 17, 2012 and October 24, 2012, Ms. Craddock failed to call the test line.
 - c. On or about May 9, 2013, Ms. Craddock failed to submit a screen for testing.
- 2. Ms. Craddock may have violated § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code in that, on or about November 18, 2013, in the Virginia Beach General District Court, she was convicted of misdemeanor shoplifting.
