CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Shanteequa Jones, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Jones' application for registration to practice as a medication aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Shanteequa Jones submitted an application for registration as a medication aide by examination which was received by the Board on July 9, 2014.
- 2. On March 30, 2010, Ms. Jones was convicted of one count of misdemeanor shoplifting in the City of Virginia Beach, Virginia, General District Court. Ms. Jones was sentenced to 30 days in jail with 30 days suspended and was placed on probation for a period of three years. Ms. Jones was ordered to pay \$18.24 in restitution and a \$250.00 fine.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of §54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
 - 2. Ms. Jones otherwise meets the requirements of §54.1-3042 of the Code.

CONSENT

Shanteequa Jones, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for registration to practice as a medication aide in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of Shanteequa Jones for registration as a medication aide is hereby APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the Medication Aide examination, Ms. Jones shall be issued an unrestricted registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth.
 - 2. Ms. Jones is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. Ms. Jones shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a medication aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
