NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), LaShon Lassiter-Britt, L.P.N., who, prior to its indefinite suspension by Order of the Board of Nursing entered on May 29, 2012, held License No. 0002-068277 to practice practical nursing, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on November 19, 2014, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Lassiter-Britt will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Lassiter-Britt has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Lassiter-Britt desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive and act upon Ms. Lassiter-Britt's application for reinstatement of her license to practice practical nursing in Virginia and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Lassiter-Britt may have violated certain laws governing nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

## STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that LaShon Lassiter-Britt, L.P.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code in that on or about August 16, 2004, Ms. Lassiter-Britt was convicted of one misdemeanor count of simple worthless check, and on or about April 1, 2005, she was convicted of one misdemeanor count of worthless check on a closed account and two misdemeanor counts of simple worthless check, all in the Superior Court of Hertford County, North Carolina.
