**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Elsabet Woldemariam, L.P.N., who holds License No. 0002-079543 to practice practical nursing in Virginia, which expires on December 31, 2012, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on November 17, 2011, at 1:30 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Woldemariam will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Woldemariam has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Woldemariam desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Woldemariam may have violated certain laws and regulations governing practical nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.


**STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS**

The Board alleges that:

1. Elsabet Woldemariam, L.P.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (5) and (8) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(2)(f) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing (“Regulations”) in that during the course of her employment in May 2009, she failed on multiple occasions to administer prescribed medication (ipratropium bromide) via nebulizer to Resident A.

2. Ms. Woldemariam may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (5) and (8) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(2)(e) of the Regulations in that she falsely documented administering the medication referenced in Allegation No. 1 to Resident A.
