Dear Ms. Jabbie:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your certificate to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered December 3, 2014. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate suspended, shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your certificate to Jay Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your certificate, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your certificate shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Nursing for reinstatement of your certificate, contact Jay Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address or (804) 367-4639.

ORDER

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Jeneba Jabbie, C.N.A, pled guilty to, and was found to be guilty of felony charges in the Circuit Court for the City of Alexandria, Virginia, to wit:

1. One (1) Count of Grand Larceny; and
2. One (1) Count of Larceny with Intent to sell or Distribute.

A certified copy of the Sentencing Order is attached to this Order and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the certificate of Jeneba Jabbie, C.N.A., to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the certificate of Jeneba Jabbie, C.N.A., will be recorded as suspended. Should Ms. Jabbie seek reinstatement of her certificate pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her certificate prior to issuance of her certificate to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall

remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

This case came before the Court for sentencing of the defendant, who appeared in person with his attorney, **Lavonda Graham-Williams**. The Commonwealth was represented by **Angela Dougherty**.

On **06-26-14** the Court withheld a finding of guilt. The defendant moved the Court to suspend imposition of a sentence without a finding, which motion was denied. The Court hereby imposes a finding of guilt as to the following offenses:

The presentence report was considered and is ordered filed as a part of the record in this case in accordance with the provisions of Code § 19.2-299.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code § 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court **SENTENCES** the defendant to:



(CF14000153)

Incarceration with the **Virginia Department of Corrections** for the term of: **2 years for Grand Larceny, and 2 years for Larceny with Intent to Sell or Distribute** . The total sentence imposed is **2 years**.

These sentences shall run **concurrent with one another and consecutive** with any other sentences imposed.

The Court **SUSPENDS all but 3 months** of the **Grand Larceny** sentence and **all but 3 months** of the **Larceny with Intent to Sell or Distribute** sentence, for a period of **2 years**, for a total suspension of **all but 3 months**, upon the following condition (s):

Good behavior. The defendant shall be of good behavior for **2 years** from the defendant's release from confinement.

Substance Abuse Screening. The Defendant shall complete any substance abuse screening, assessment, testing and treatment as directed by the Department of Corrections. The Defendant may be subject to payment of any fees associated with substance abuse treatment or intervention as required by the treatment or intervention program on an ability to pay basis.

No Contact with Victim. The defendant shall have no further contact with the victim in this case.

Sheriff's Modified Work Release Program. The defendant may serve the sentence imposed in the Sheriff's Modified Work Release Program, if eligible.

Supervised probation. The defendant is placed on probation to commence on his release from incarceration, under the supervision of a Probation Officer for **2 years** or unless sooner released by the court. The defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer. Probation shall include substance abuse counseling and/or testing and participation in shoplifting class as prescribed by the Probation Officer.

Costs. The defendant shall pay costs of **\$825.00**.

Restitution. It is further ordered pursuant to the provision of §19.2-305.1 Code of Virginia, that the defendant shall make restitution pursuant to a plan to be filed with the Court.

Credit for time served. The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Code § 53.1-187.
