ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and issues this Order affecting the registration of Happie C. Harris, R.M.A., to practice as a medication aide in Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Happie C. Harris, R.M.A., was issued Registration No. 0031-004843 to practice as a medication aide by the Virginia Board of Nursing on March 8, 2011. Said registration is scheduled to expire on March 31, 2015.
- 2. By Order of the Board entered on October 7, 2010, the Board placed Ms. Harris on probation with terms and conditions, until such time as she successfully completed her supervised probation with the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia.
 - 3. Ms. Harris submitted a petition for release from probation on July 3, 2014.
 - 4. Ms. Harris has complied with all terms and conditions of probation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. This matter is properly before the Board.
- 2. Happie C. Harris, R.M.A., has demonstrated satisfactory evidence to warrant release from probation.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petition of Happie C. Harris, R.M.A., for release from probation is hereby GRANTED and Ms. Harris shall be issued an unrestricted registration to practice as a medication aide.

Ms. Harris shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a medication aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq*. of the Code and the Regulations Governing the Registration of Medication Aides.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
