NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Happie C. Harris is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on September 15, 2010, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Harris will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Harris has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Harris desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.


The purpose of the hearing is to receive and act upon Happie C. Harris' applications for certification by examination as a nurse aide and registration by examination as a medication aide, and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Harris may have violated certain laws governing the practice of nurse aides and the practice of medication aides in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

The burden rests upon Ms. Harris, as the applicant, to demonstrate that she meets the requirements of §§ 54.1-3023 and 54.1-3042 of the Code.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Happie C. Harris may have violated § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code in that on or about August 6, 2009, she was convicted of one felony count of bank fraud and one felony count of conspiracy to commit bank fraud in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia.
