Dear Ms. Velvin:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice as a professional nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered June 3, 2003. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of thirty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

ORDER

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, Robert A. Nebiker, the Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Barbara Annette Powell Velvin, R.N., was convicted of felony charges in the Circuit Court of the County of Mecklenburg for the Commonwealth of Virginia, to wit: Two (2) counts of Obtain Drugs By Fraud. A certified copy of the Sentencing Order is attached and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Barbara Annette Powell Velvin, R.N., to practice as a Professional Nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Barbara Annette Powell Velvin, R.N., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current. In the event that Ms. Velvin seeks reinstatement of her license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Section 2.2-4023 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

This case came before the Court for sentencing of the defendant, who appeared in person with her attorney, Charles G. Butts, Jr. The Commonwealth was represented by Jonathan E. Green.

On March 7, 2003 the defendant was found guilty of the following offenses:

The presentence report was considered and is ordered filed as a part of the record in this case in accordance with the provisions of Code § 19.2-299.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code § 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court SENTENCES the defendant to:

Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: 5 years on each charge. The total sentence imposed is 10 years.

CR03-323/VELVIN

The Court **SUSPENDS** all of the said sentences, upon the following conditions:

Good behavior. The defendant shall be of good behavior for 10 years.

Supervised probation. The defendant is placed on probation to commence on this date, under the supervision of a Probation Officer for 1 year, or unless sooner released by the court or by the Probation Officer. The defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the probation officer. Probation shall include substance abuse counseling and/or testing as prescribed by the Probation Officer.

Costs. The defendant shall pay costs of \$ 731.00.


It is further ORDERED that the defendant's privilege to drive or operate a motor vehicle, engine, or train in the Commonwealth be suspended for a period of six months on each conviction (a total suspension of 12 months) from this date. Such license forfeiture shall be in addition to and shall run consecutively with any other license suspension, revocation or forfeiture in effect or imposed upon the defendant.

The Court certifies that at all times during the trial of this case, the defendant was personally present with her attorney.

And the defendant is allowed to depart.


