Dear Ms. Barlow:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered October 23, 2009. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Nursing for reinstatement of your license, contact Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address or (804) 367-4599.


ORDER

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, Sandra Whitley Ryals, Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Virginia Leigh Barlow, R.N., was found guilty of a felony charge in the Circuit Court of the County of Isle of Wight for the Commonwealth of Virginia to wit: One (1) Count of Possession of Cocaine. A certified copy of the Sentencing Order entered on October 7, 2009, is attached to this Order and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Virginia Leigh Barlow, R.N., to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Virginia Leigh Barlow, R.N., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current. Should Ms. Barlow seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.



WHEREUPON THE ACCUSED WAS ARRAIGNED ON A CHARGE OF POSSESSION OF COCAINE, AND AFTER PRIVATE CONSULTATION WITH AND BEING ADVISED BY HIS SAID COUNSEL, PLEAD GUILTY TO THE INDICTMENT, PURSUANT TO A PLEA AGREEMENT PRESENTED TO THE COURT, WHICH PLEA WAS TENDERED BY THE ACCUSED IN PERSON, AND THE COURT HAVING MADE INQUIRY AND BEING OF THE OPINION THAT THE ACCUSED FULLY UNDERSTOOD THE NATURE AND EFFECT OF HER PLEA AND OF THE PENALTIES THAT MAY BE IMPOSED UPON HER CONVICTION AND OF THE WAIVER OF TRIAL BY JURY AND OF APPEAL, AND FINDING THAT THE PLEA WAS VOLUNTARILY AND INTELLIGENTLY MADE, AND HAVING HEARD THE STIPULATED EVIDENCE OF THE ATTORNEY FOR THE COMMONWEALTH, THE COURT ACCEPTS SAID AGREEMENT AND THE PLEA OF GUILTY OF THE DEFENDANT AND FINDS THE DEFENDANT GUILTY.

The defendant was remanded to the custody of the sheriff. The defendant was allowed to depart.

The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Virginia Code § 53.1-187.
