CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing (“Board”) and Raytrinique L. Person, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Person’s application for licensure by examination to practice as a professional nurse in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Raytrinique L. Person submitted an application for licensure by examination to practice as a professional nurse which was received by the Board on September 2, 2014.
2. On July 18, 2012, Ms. Person was convicted in the General District Court of the City of Colonial Heights, Virginia of one count of petit larceny, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. She was sentenced to 90 days incarceration, with all 90 days suspended, ordered to take a shoplifting prevention class and pay \$100.00 in fines and \$81.00 in costs, and placed on probation for three years.
3. Ms. Person provided evidence to the Board that all court costs and restitution were paid in full and that she took the required class.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Finding of Fact No. 3 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”).
2. Ms. Person otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3017 of the Code.

CONSENT

Raytrinique L. Person, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for licensure to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Raytrinique L. Person for licensure by examination as a professional nurse is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NCLEX-RN examination, Ms. Person shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice as a professional nurse in the Commonwealth.
2. Ms. Person is hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Ms. Person shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.

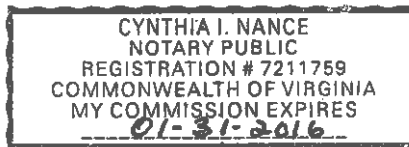
