Dear Ms. Davis:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your certificate to practice as a certified nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered October 20, 2014. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate suspended, shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your certificate to Jay Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your certificate, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your certificate shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I,

David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon

evidence that Carrie Lynn Davis, C.N.A., pled guilty to, and was found to be guilty of felony charges in the

Circuit Court for the County of Rockbridge, Virginia, to wit:

Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her

certificate prior to issuance of her certificate to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall

remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

This day came the Attorney for the Commonwealth and Carrie Lynn Davis, who stands indicted for felonies, to-wit: credit card theft, obtaining money by false pretense, credit card forgery, and grand larceny, appeared according to the conditions of her recognizance and came also M. Teresa Harris, the Assistant Public Defender.

Whereupon the accused was arraigned and after private consultation with and being advised by her said counsel, pleaded guilty to the Indictments, which pleas were tendered by the accused in person.

Whereupon the Court made inquiry of the accused in the manner provided in Part 3A, Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia, and did determine that the accused fully understood the nature and effect of her pleas, the penalties that could be imposed upon her conviction, the waiver of trial by jury and appeal, and did further determine that the pleas were voluntarily and intelligently given after the advice of said counsel.

Whereupon the Court proceeded to hear and determine the cases without the intervention of a jury, as provided by law, and having heard the evidence and argument of counsel finds the accused guilty of obtaining money by false pretense, credit card forgery, and grand larceny, as charged in the Indictments.

The Court, on motion of the defendant, by counsel, before fixing punishment or imposing sentence, directs the Probation Officer of this Court to thoroughly investigate and report to the



Court as provided by law, and sentencing is set for 1:30 p.m. on December 1, 2014, to which time this case is continued.

The defendant is released on her existing bond until such time as this Court shall fix punishment or impose sentence in this case.
