NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Krista Y. Schofield, C.N.A., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on May 23, 2013, held Certificate No. 1401-126021 to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on July 15, 2013, at 1:30 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Schofield will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


At the hearing, Ms. Schofield has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Schofield desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Krista Y. Schofield, C.N.A., may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on February 3, 2012, and certain laws and regulations governing nurse aide practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Krista Y. Schofield, C.N.A., may have violated Term No. 4(a) of the Order of the Board entered February 3, 2012, which required her to comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), and § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code, in that she was dismissed from the HPMP on or about May 20, 2013, for failure to comply with the urine toxicology screening program.
