ORDER

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 54.1-110 and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), a formal administrative hearing was held before a panel of the Board of Nursing ("Board") on September 15, 2014, in Henrico County, Virginia, to inquire into evidence that Monica Stokes Cooper, R.M.A., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing nurse aide practice and medication aide practice in Virginia. The case was presented by Cynthia E. Gaines, Adjudication Specialist, Administrative Proceedings Division. Erin Barrett, Assistant Attorney General, was present as legal counsel for the Board. Ms. Stokes Cooper was not present and was not represented by legal counsel. The proceedings were recorded by a certified court reporter.

Upon consideration of the evidence presented, the Board adopted the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Monica Stokes Cooper, R.M.A., was issued Registration No. 0031-002697 to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia on March 9, 2009. Said registration expired on August 31, 2014.
2. Based upon the representations of Cynthia E. Gaines, Adjudication Specialist, and Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1, the Notice of Formal Hearing and Affidavit of Mailing, the presiding officer ruled that adequate notice was provided to the respondent and the hearing proceeded in her absence.
3. In November 2013, during the course of her employment with Assistance in Living at Atlantic Shores ALF, Virginia Beach, Virginia, Ms. Stokes stole a gift card from Resident A.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that Finding of Fact No. 3 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(2), (5) and (8) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-60-120(2)(i) of the Regulations Governing the Registration of Medication Aides.


ORDER

WHEREFORE, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The right of Monica Stokes Cooper to renew Registration No. 0031-002697 to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby REVOKED.
2. The registration of Ms. Stokes Cooper will be recorded as REVOKED. Pursuant to § 54.1-2408.2 of the Code, should Ms. Stokes Cooper seek reinstatement of her registration after three years, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement of her registration prior to issuance of her registration to resume practice. The reinstatement of Ms. Stokes Cooper's registration shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members at a meeting of the Board.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.
