NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Angela R. Rorrer, R.N., who prior to the rescission of the stay of indefinite suspension by the Board of Nursing on March 23, 2011, held License No. 0001-127241 to practice professional nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on September 12, 2011, at 9:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Rorrer will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Rorrer has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Rorrer desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Angela R. Rorrer, R.N., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing professional nursing practice in Virginia and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Rorrer may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Consent

Order of the Board entered on September 18, 2008, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

1. Angela R. Rorrer, R.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term No. 3 of the Consent Order entered September 18, 2008, which required her to remain compliant with a Recovery Monitoring Contract with the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), in that, on or about March 18, 2011, Ms. Rorrer was dismissed from the HPMP for noncompliance. Specifically:

a. Ms. Rorrer failed to report a prescription for Nucynta (tapentadol, Schedule II) obtained on or about February 17, 2011.

b. Ms. Rorrer failed to report a prescription for Percocet (oxycodone/APAP, Schedule II) obtained on or about February 2, 2011, and she failed to have the prescriber submit the PRN Physician Report.


c. Between March 16, 2009, and February 10, 2011, Ms. Rorrer failed to call the urine drug screen test line on at least six occasions, which resulted in two missed drug screens.

d. Ms. Rorrer failed to attend five of seven scheduled treatment sessions in November and December, 2010.

2. Ms. Rorrer may have violated § 54.1-3007(2) and (5) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(c) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing in that during the course of her employment with HealthSouth Rehabilitation Hospital, Richmond, Virginia, on or about April 16, 2008, Ms. Rorrer diverted heparin, sodium chloride, calcium carbonate and syringes for unauthorized use.

3. Ms. Rorrer may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code in that on or about July 22, 2008, in the General District Court of Chesterfield County, Virginia, Ms. Rorrer was convicted of driving while under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol, a misdemeanor, subsequent to a motor vehicle accident that occurred on or about April 16, 2008.
