## **CONSENT ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Danielle Askew, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Askew's application for certification to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

# FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Danielle Askew submitted an application for certification by examination as a nurse aide to the Board on June 23, 2014.
- 2. On April 16, 2010, Ms. Askew was convicted in the General District Court of the City of Chesapeake, Virginia, of petit larceny, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.
- 3. Ms. Askew stated in a July 3, 2014, letter to the Board that she has paid all fines and costs and that she has completed all court-ordered requirements associated with the conviction.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
  - 2. Ms. Askew otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3023 of the Code.

#### **CONSENT**

Danielle Askew, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
  - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for certification to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

## **ORDER**

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The application of Danielle Askew for certification by examination as a nurse aide is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NNAAP examination, Ms. Askew shall be issued an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth.
  - 2. Ms. Askew is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. Ms. Askew shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq*. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
