## CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Natalie Olson, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Olson's application for licensure by examination to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Natalie Olson submitted an application for licensure by examination to practice professional nursing to the Board on July 10, 2014.
- 2. On November 4, 2011, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia, Ms. Olson pled guilty to and was convicted of misdemeanor theft of government property based on shoplifting from a military exchange. She was sentenced to six months' supervised probation and ordered to complete a theft prevention seminar and pay a fine and a special assessment.
- 3. Ms. Olson provided evidence that she completed the service of her sentence as of May 2012 and that she had paid the fines and special assessment.

# **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
  - 2. Ms. Olson otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3017 of the Code.

#### CONSENT

Natalie Olson, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
  - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for licensure to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

## <u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of Natalie Olson for licensure by examination to practice professional nursing is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NCLEX-RN Examination, Ms. Olson shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice professional nursing in Virginia.
  - 2. Ms. Olson is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. Ms. Olson shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

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Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
