NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Audrey W. Hollar, R.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on June 5, 2014, held License No. 0001-117631 to practice professional nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on August 18, 2014, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Hollar will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


At the hearing, Ms. Hollar has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Hollar desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Hollar may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on July 31, 2012 (“Board’s Order”) and certain laws governing the practice of nursing, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Audrey W. Hollar, R.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term No. 6 of the Board's Order, which stayed the indefinite suspension of her license to practice professional nursing contingent upon her compliance with the terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") for the period specified by the HPMP, in that she resigned from the HPMP on or about October 15, 2013.
