AMENDED NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Andrea Harris, R.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on June 12, 2015, held License No. 0001-201294 to practice professional nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on November 19, 2015 at 11:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Harris will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Harris has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Harris desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the <u>Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas</u>.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Andrea Harris, R.N., may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on October 2, 2014 ("Board's Order"), as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Andrea Harris, R.N., may have violated Term No. 6(a) of the Board's Order, which required that she comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"). By letter dated May 4, 2015, Ms. Harris resigned from the HPMP. Additionally, beginning on or about April 27, 2015, Ms. Harris became noncompliant with the HPMP toxicology testing requirements.
