Dear Ms. Johnson:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered July 23, 2015. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

CORRECTED ORDER -CASE NO. CR14-3107-00F

On April 8, 2015, came Po Chau, the attorney for the Commonwealth and Carolina Ann Johnson, born September 11, 1983, who stands indicted for a felony, towit: prescription fraud (Virginia Code Section 18.2-258.1(A)), as charged in the indictment, appeared according to the conditions of her bond and came also James T. Maloney, her attorney heretofore retained, pursuant to sentencing.

On December 2, 2014, the defendant was found guilty of the following offense:

Pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheet. The sentencing guidelines worksheet and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

And it being demanded of the defendant if anything for herself she had or knew to say why judgment should not be pronounced against her according to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgment, the Court sentences the defendant to incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for a term of three (3) years and thirty (30) days, the execution of three (3) years of which sentence is suspended for five (5) years, on condition that she keep the peace and be of good behavior, that she abstain from the use of alcohol and illegal substances, and that upon her release from incarceration she report to be placed on supervision with the District #32 Office of Probation and Parole, where she will submit to alcohol and substance abuse testing and screening and obey all rules and recommendations required by her probation officer.

The Court orders that the defendant's operator's license is suspended for six (6) months, which can be restricted if she is deemed eligible by the Department of Motor Vehicles, and that she pay the costs of this case in the amount of \$1,055.00.

By operation of law, the defendant's privilege to operate a motor vehicle shall be suspended by the Department of Motor Vehicles effective thirty days from this date if the costs are not paid pursuant to Virginia Code Section 46.2-395.

The Court certifies that at all times during this proceeding the defendant was present in person and her attorney was likewise present in person and capably represented the defendant.

Thereupon the defendant was remanded to the custody of the Sheriff.

At the expiration of one (1) year from the entry of this order if the defendant has not filed a Notice of Appeal, and pursuant to Virginia Code Section 19.2-270.4, the Clerk is ordered to destroy one (1) letter, one (1) copy of Order of Summary Suspension and one (1) copy of an order from the Board of Nursing, introduced into evidence as Commonwealth's Exhibit #1, 1A, 1B; and one (1) letter from the Department of Health introduced into evidence and Defense Exhibit #1, in any manner she deems appropriate, making an affidavit thereof and placing it in the file.
