## **CONSENT ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Passang Dhonden, C.N.A., as evidenced by his signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. Dhonden's certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Passang Dhonden, C.N.A., was issued Certificate No. 1401-154769 to practice as a nurse aide by the Virginia Board of Nursing on August 6, 2012. Said certificate is set to expire on August 31, 2014.
- 2. During his employment at Sunrise at Hunter Mill Assisted Living Facility, Oakton, Virginia, on November 4, 2013, when assigned to monitor a resident who was prone to falling, Mr. Dhonden fell asleep in said resident's room.
- 3. Mr. Dhonden's employment at Sunrise at Hunter Mill was terminated on November 12, 2013, as a result of this incident.

# **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of §54.1-3007(5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").

## **CONSENT**

Passang Dhonden, by affixing his signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. Mr. Dhonden has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

- 2. Mr. Dhonden acknowledges that without his consent, no legal action can be taken against him except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. Mr. Dhonden acknowledges that he has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against him;
  - 4. Mr. Dhonden waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. Mr. Dhonden admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives his right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. Mr. Dhonden consents to the entry of the following Order affecting his right to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

#### **ORDER**

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows: Passang Dhonden, C.N.A., is REPRIMANDED.

2. Mr. Dhonden shall maintain a course of conduct in his capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
