CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Kacy Nobles, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Nobles' application for licensure to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Kacy Nobles submitted an application for licensure by examination to practice as a practical nurse in Virginia on April 21, 2014.
- 2. Ms. Nobles was convicted of one count of misdemeanor shoplifting, a crime of moral turpitude, in the City of Norfolk, Virginia, General District Court on July 24, 2012. She was sentenced to 90 days in jail with 90 days suspended and she was placed on unsupervised probation for two years. She was also ordered to complete larceny counseling.
- 3. Ms. Nelson was convicted of a probation violation in the Norfolk General District Court on October 4, 2012, in relation to her shoplifting conviction. She was sentenced to 90 days in jail with 90 days suspended.
- 4. Ms. Nelson completed all requirements set forth by the court and her probation officer and was released from probation on October 4, 2013.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of §54.1-3007 (4) of the Code of Virginia, (1950), as amended ("Code").

2. Ms. Nobles otherwise meets the requirements of §54.1-3020 of the Code.

CONSENT

Kacy Nobles, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for licensure to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

<u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of Kacy Nobles for licensure by examination as a practical nurse is hereby APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NCLEX-PN examination, Ms. Nobles shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice as a practical nurse in the Commonwealth.
 - Ms. Nobles is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Ms. Nobles shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.
