**NOTICE OF HEARING**

at which time Mr. Lowry will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Mr. Lowry has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on his behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Mr. Lowry desires any

witnesses to appear on his behalf, he must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Robert W. Lowry, R.N. may have violated

certain terms and conditions imposed on him as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on September 16,

2014, and certain laws governing nursing practice in Virginia.

## STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Robert W. Lowry, R.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term No. 5 of the Order of the Board entered September 16, 2014, which required him to comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") for the period specified by the HPMP, in that he was dismissed from the HPMP on May 15, 2015 for noncompliance, including failure to enter and complete treatment as recommended and failure to comply with the toxicology screening program.
