

**VIRGINIA:**

**BEFORE THE BOARD OF NURSING**

**IN RE:**

**ANGELA JEAN SCHROEDER, L.P.N.**

**ORDER**

Pursuant to § 2.2-4019, § 2.2-4021, and § 54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (the "Code"), a Special Conference Committee ("Committee") of the Board of Nursing met on December 5, 2005, in Henrico County, Virginia, to receive and act upon evidence that Angela Jean Schroeder, L.P.N., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of practical nursing in Virginia. Ms. Schroeder was present and was not represented by counsel. Upon consideration of the evidence presented, the Committee adopted the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Angela Jean Schroeder, L.P.N., holds License No. 0002-067101 issued by the Virginia Board of Nursing.
2. Ms. Schroeder was properly noticed for this informal conference by letters dated July 22, 2005 and August 30, 2005.
3. On March 3, 2005, Ms. Schroeder signed a Participation Contract with the Health Practitioners' Intervention Program ("HPIP"), pursuant to Chapter 25.1 of Title 54.1 of the Code, and 18 VAC 76-10-10, et seq., of the Regulations Governing the HPIP. On July 21, 2005, she signed a Recovery Monitoring Contract ("Contract") which is effective for five (5) years from the date of signature. Ms. Schroeder provided a copy of this signed contract to the Committee.
4. Based on the finding that no report of possible violation of law or regulation has

been made against Ms. Schroeder, other than impairment or the diversion of controlled substances for personal use, the Committee defers further findings of fact concerning Ms. Schroeder at this time.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Based on the above Findings of Fact, the Committee concludes that Angela Jean Schroeder, L.P.N., is properly enrolled in the Health Practitioners' Intervention Program ("HPIP").

### **ORDER**

On the basis of the foregoing, the Committee, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS that it shall TAKE NO ACTION at this time contingent expressly upon Ms. Schroeder's continued compliance with the following terms and conditions:

1. Ms. Schroeder shall comply with all terms and conditions of the Contract with the HPIP for the period specified in the Contract.
2. Any violation of the terms and conditions stated in this Order shall be reason for revoking the license of Ms. Schroeder, and an administrative proceeding shall be held to decide whether her license shall be revoked. Ms. Schroeder shall be noticed to appear before a Committee at such time as the Board is notified that:
  - a) Ms. Schroeder is not in compliance with the terms and conditions of the HPIP, or has been terminated from participation in the HPIP, or
  - b) There is a pending investigation or unresolved allegations against Ms. Schroeder involving a violation of law, regulation or any term or condition of probation or this Order, or

- c) Ms. Schroeder has successfully completed the above-referenced period of participation in the HPIP. However, upon receipt of evidence of Ms. Schroeder's participation in and compliance with the HPIP, the Committee, at its discretion, may waive Ms. Schroeder's appearance before the Committee, and conduct an administrative review of this matter.

This order shall be applicable to Ms. Schroeder's Multistate licensure privileges, if any, to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia. It is further ordered that for the duration of this order, Ms. Schroeder may not work outside of the Commonwealth of Virginia pursuant to a multistate licensure privilege without the written permission of the Virginia Board of Nursing and the Board of Nursing in the party state where the respondent wishes to work. Any requests for out of state employment should be directed, in writing, to the Executive Director of the Board.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.

If Ms. Schroeder does not consent to the Committee's decision and desires a hearing before the Board or a panel thereof, she shall notify, in writing, Jay P. Douglas, R.N., M.S.M., C.S.A.C., Executive Director, Board of Nursing, 6603 W. Broad Street, Fifth Floor, Richmond, Virginia 23230-1712, within thirty-three (33) days from the date of entry of this Order. This Order shall become final upon the expiration of the thirty-three (33) day period unless a written request for a formal hearing is received within such time. Upon receiving timely request for a hearing, the Board or panel thereof shall then proceed with a hearing as provided in § 2.2-4020 and § 2.2-4021 of the

Code of Virginia (1950), as amended.
