CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Dorothy M. De'Braux, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. De'Braux's application for certification as a nurse aide by examination in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. By application received May 8, 2014, Dorothy M. De'Braux applied for certification by examination as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

2. Ms. De'Braux has several misdemeanor convictions in the General District Court for the City of Chesapeake, Virginia. Specifically:

a. On July 12, 2007, Ms. De'Braux was convicted of one count of petit larceny, she was ordered to pay \$301.00 in fines and costs, which were paid on March 11, 2008.

b. On November 16, 2009, she was convicted of two counts of shoplifting. She was ordered to pay \$533.00 in fines and costs, which were paid on May 18, 2012.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").

2. Ms. De'Braux otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3023 of the Code.

CONSENT

Dorothy M. De'Braux, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Consent Order affecting her application for certification to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.


ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Consent Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Dorothy M. De’Braux for certification as a nurse aide by examination is hereby APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program examination, the Board shall issue Ms. De’Braux an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
2. Ms. De’Braux is hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Ms. De’Braux shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.



Dear Ms. De'Braux:

The review of your application for nurse aide certification by examination is complete. The Board is willing to offer you a Pre-Hearing Consent Order in lieu of having you appear at an Informal Conference to consider your application.

This consent order will be sent to you under a separate cover in roughly 30 days after it has been prepared by the Administrative Proceedings Division. It will approve you for certification in Virginia once you have taken and passed the nurse aide competency test and place a reprimand on that certificate. If you do not wish to sign the consent order after you have received and read it over, an informal conference will be scheduled upon written notification from you that you do not plan to sign the order.
