NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Kimberly A. Anderson, who, prior to its mandatory suspension by the Department of Health

Professions on November 22, 2013, held License No. 0001-242376 to practice professional nursing in

Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of

the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on July 14, 2014, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the

Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201,

Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Anderson will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person

or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Anderson has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Anderson desires any

witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive and act upon Ms. Anderson's application for reinstatement of her license to practice professional nursing in Virginia and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Anderson may

have violated certain laws and regulations governing nursing practice in Virginia as more fully set forth in

the Statement of Particulars below.

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The burden rests upon Ms. Anderson, as the applicant, to demonstrate that she is capable of resuming the safe and competent practice of nursing in Virginia.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2409 of the Code, reinstatement of Ms. Anderson's license requires the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board in attendance at the hearing.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

Kimberly A. Anderson may have violated § 54.1-3007(7) of the Code in that the State of Maine Board of Nursing accepted on October 21, 2013, in lieu of further disciplinary proceedings, the voluntary surrender of her license to practice nursing in Maine. The voluntary surrender of Ms. Anderson's Maine license formed the basis of the mandatory suspension on November 22, 2013 of her license to practice nursing in Virginia.
