**ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing (“Board”) enters the following Order affecting the license of Shannon Kareem, R.N., to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Shannon Kareem, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-242064 to practice professional nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on January 3, 2013. Said license is set to expire on June 30, 2015. Her primary state of residence is Michigan.
2. By Consent Order entered January 2, 2013 (“Board’s Order”), the Board approved Ms. Kareem’s application for licensure to practice professional nursing in Virginia and placed her on probation for one year of actual nursing practice under certain terms and conditions.
3. In a report dated May 19, 2014, the Compliance Case Manager for the Board indicated that Ms. Kareem had substantially complied with the terms of the Board’s Order.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


This matter is properly before the Board.

**ORDER**

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS that Shannon Kareem, R.N. is hereby released from probation. Ms. Kareem shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
