ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") enters the following Order affecting the license of Billie A. Farmer, R.N., to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Billie A. Farmer, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-241766 to practice professional nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on December 3, 2012. Said license is set to expire on November 30, 2014. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. By Order entered November 20, 2012 ("Board's Order"), the Board approved Ms. Farmer's application for licensure by endorsement to practice professional nursing and placed her on indefinite probation for not less than 12 months of actual nursing practice under certain terms and conditions.
3. In a report dated May 19, 2014, the Compliance Case Manager for the Board indicated that Ms. Farmer had substantially complied with the terms of the Board's Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


This matter is properly before the Board.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS that Billie A. Farmer, R.N. is hereby released from probation. Ms. Farmer shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
