ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") enters the following Order affecting the certificate of Tora Duong, C.M.T., to practice massage therapy in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Tora Duong, C.M.T., was issued Certificate No. 0019-011394 to practice massage therapy in Virginia on April 17, 2013. She also holds a certificate to practice massage therapy in the State of Colorado.
2. By Order entered April 3, 2013 ("Board's Order"), the Board approved Ms. Duong's application for certification to practice massage therapy in Virginia and placed her on probation for 12 months of actual massage therapy practice under certain terms and conditions.
3. In a report dated April 21, 2014, the Compliance Case Manager for the Board indicated that Ms. Duong had substantially complied with the terms of the Board's Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


This matter is properly before the Board.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS that Tora Duong, C.M.T. is hereby released from probation. Ms. Duong shall be issued an unrestricted certificate to practice massage therapy in Virginia.
