**ORDER**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") enters the following Order affecting the license of Katharine Kuper, R.N., to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Katharine Kuper, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-210756 to practice professional nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on January 4, 2008. Said license is set to expire on September 30, 2015. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. By Order entered February 12, 2014 ("Board's Order"), the Board required Ms. Kuper to undergo an evaluation by a mental health specialist and to have a written report of the evaluation sent to the Board.
3. Ms. Kuper obtained the required evaluation. The report of the evaluation revealed no condition that requires further action by the Board.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Ms. Kuper has satisfied the term imposed by the Board's Order.

**ORDER**

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS that Katharine Kuper, R.N. is hereby released from the terms of the Board's Order. Ms. Kuper shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
