CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Lisa M. Vines, R.N., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Vines' application for reinstatement of her license to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Lisa M. Vines, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-148840 to practice professional nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on June 27, 1996. Said license was suspended by Order of the Virginia Department of Health Professions entered March 12, 2013. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. Ms. Vines submitted an application for reinstatement of her license which was received by the Board on April 9, 2013.
3. Pursuant to an Order of the Board entered September 28, 2007, the Board indefinitely suspended Ms. Vines' license, with said suspension stayed contingent upon her compliance with the Intervention Project for Nurses in Florida ("IPN"), due to diversion and substance abuse. In accordance with the Board Order entered September 28, 2007, the stay of suspension of Ms. Vines' license was summarily rescinded on February 10, 2012, pursuant to Term No. 3 of the Order. By Order entered May 1, 2012, Ms.

Vines' Virginia license was reinstated and she was reprimanded due to findings that Ms. Vines was dismissed from the IPN for failing to comply with the conditions of her contract.

4. By Final Order entered February 20, 2013, the Florida State Board of Nursing suspended Ms. Vines' license for two years due to her December 1, 2011, dismissal from the IPN. Said suspension was the basis of the March 12, 2013, mandatory suspension of her license to practice in Virginia.

5. Ms. Vines was employed at Southeastern Virginia Training Center, Chesapeake, Virginia, from October, 10, 2012 to March 25, 2013, when her license was suspended.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Finding of Fact No. 4 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(7) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").

CONSENT

Lisa M. Vines, R.N., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to a formal fact finding hearing before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to a formal hearing;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;

6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for reinstatement of her license to practice professional nursing in Virginia.


ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The license of Lisa M. Vines, R.N., to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby REINSTATED.
2. Ms. Vines is hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Ms. Vines shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.

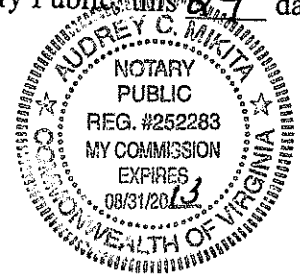
