**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), Lisa M. Vines, R.N., who, prior to the rescission of the stay of indefinite suspension by the Board of Nursing on February 10, 2012, held License No. 0001-148840 to practice professional nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on April 16, 2012, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Vines will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


At the hearing, Ms. Vines has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Vines desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Lisa M. Vines, R.N., may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on September 28, 2007, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

**STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS**

The Board alleges that Lisa M. Vines, R.N., may have violated Term No. 3 of the Order entered September 28, 2007, which required her to remain compliant with the Intervention Project for Nurses (“IPN”) in Florida, in that, on or about December 1, 2011, Ms. Vines was dismissed from the IPN for failing to comply with the conditions of her IPN Advocacy Contract.
